
Kurana Memorial Map: C5

Major Mitchell Lookout Map: C5 The plaque erected at this lookout commemorates the naming on 30th December 1836 of Mount Macedon by Major Thomas Mitchell, Surveyor General of the Colony of NSW.

Memorial Cross Map: C5


Trigonometry Cairn Map: C5 Erected in 1853, the Cairn is on the exit road from the Cross Reserve. From this point, all surveys in this district originated.

Stanley Park Map: C6 Situated in Salisbury Road where Turitable Creek cascades over an ancient lava flow. There are BBQ facilities, tennis courts, playground equipment and pleasant walking tracks.

Places Of Interest

The Macedon Reservoir Map: B6

Enjoy swimming and bushwalking around 'The Res' with close access to the Woodend to Macedon Shared Trail. You'll find it on the Nursery Road, Macedon.

On the summit of Mount Macedon is Macedon Regional Park. Numerous walking tracks and picnic grounds are provided.

This memorial recognises the 50th anniversary and commemorates the DC3 "Kurana" aircraft disaster in 1948.

With glorious views, the Cross commemorates those who gave their lives in the 1914 - 1918 war. The Cross is 21m in height and 1001m above sea level, the original structure was unveiled in 1935, but due to storm and fire damage, it was replaced in 1995.

Macedon Horse Trough Map: C7

The horse trough and hitching rail is located opposite the hotel next to the public amenities. The horse trough reinstates the horse trough damaged in the 1983 bushfires. These horse troughs were placed

throughout Australia to provide water for the many animals that travelled long journeys throughout the vast countryside.

Ash Wednesday Park Map:C7

A leafy picturesque park that provides playground equipment, a bicycle repair station, undercover BBQ facilities, and stage. The park was born as a phoenix to commemorate the Ash Wednesday bushfires of 1983 and is a short distance from the Macedon Railway station.

Camels Hump Map: D4

The Camels Hump is the highest point in the Macedon Ranges, with a lookout offering visitors spectacular views. This is one of three local rocky outcrops formed by volcanic action millions of years ago.

Private Gardens Map: D5

Many gardens at Macedon and Mount Macedon are opened to the public for the 'Open Gardens Victoria'. "Forest Glade" on Mount Macedon Road is open all year round. "The Stokes Collection" at Forest Glade is the largest 18th and 19th Century antique collection in the Southern Hemisphere. The Duneira garden and homestead can be viewed by appointment.

Centennial Park Map: D7

A leafy picturesque park located at the intersection of Honour Avenue and Mount Macedon Road Macedon that provides undercover BBQ facilities and public amenities. View the collection of stone statues depicting the area's history.

Sanatorium Lake Map: E4

This man-made lake, famous for its intense reflections, was built to provide water supply for a proposed Sanatorium for tuberculosis patients. Although it was not built at this site, the lake remains as a tranguil place and as a reminder of advances made in medical science over the years.
